# Construction and Demolition Debris

## 2014 RESIDENTS & MINOR HAULERS FEES

C&D materials are generated by construction, demolition and remodeling. Debris is C&D materials that are unable to be salvaged or recycled.

BURNABLE MATERIALS	NON-BURNABLE MATERIALS
Wood, asphalt shingles	Sheetrock, concrete, stone, brick, asphalt, soil, glass, plaster, lath, fiberglass, siding (vinyl, asbestos), non friable asbestos shingles, ceramic tubs, sinks, toilets and tiles
ALL SCRAP METAL MUST BE SEPARATED	
Metal sheeting, flashing, plumbing fixtures, piping, wire, rebar, aluminum, large metal appliances, metal storm doors and windows with no glass	
<b>Oswego County Recycling and Solid Waste Local Law, Section 4, 9 "Flow Control" requires that all Construction &amp; Demolition Debris generated or collected within Oswego County must be delivered to Oswego County Solid Waste Facilities</b>	

*All residents and haulers must follow the instruction of the transfer station attendant on duty.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF	RESIDENT FEES	MINOR HAULER FEES
<b>C&amp;D, including carpet</b>	<b>WEIGH AND PAY</b> <b>\$10 Minimum weigh fee</b>  <b>\$100/ton</b> <b>(5¢ per pound)</b> at Transfer Stations	\$50 annual application, includes one vehicle \$20 per additional vehicle  <b>WEIGH AND PAY</b> <b>\$10 Minimum weigh fee</b> <b>\$100/ton (5¢ per pound)</b> at Transfer Stations <b>\$60/ton (3¢ per pound)</b> at Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)
<b>All Scrap Metal</b>	<b>No Fee for scrap metal, only.</b> <b>CFC (refrigerant) containing unit has a \$15 fee at Transfer Stations</b>	
<b>Asbestos</b> Friable asbestos must be double bagged.	<b>WEIGH AND PAY, \$10 Minimum weigh fee</b> <b>\$100/ton (5¢ per pound)</b> at Bristol Hill Landfill, ONLY

### 2014 MAJOR HAULER FEES

*All haulers must follow the instruction of the transfer station attendant on duty. Please see Hauler Permit policies for additional information.*

	TYPES OF MATERIALS	HOW TO DISPOSE	FEES \$10 Minimum weigh fee
<b>WASTE</b>	<b>Non-Burnable</b> Sheetrock, concrete, brick, asphalt, soil, glass, plaster, lath, fiberglass, siding (vinyl, asbestos), non friable asbestos shingles, ceramic tubs, sinks, toilets and tiles	Mixed loads may go to Transfer Stations or Bristol Hill.  Large loads (40 cubic yards) <i>must</i> go directly to the Bristol Hill Landfill only.	<b>Major Haulers:</b> \$100 annual application, includes one vehicle \$20 per additional vehicle at time of application <b>\$100/ton (4.75¢ per pound)</b> at Transfer Stations <b>\$47/ton (2.35¢ per pound)</b> at Bristol Hill Landfill
	<b>Burnable</b> Wood and asphalt shingles	Loads may go directly to the Energy Recovery Facility (ERF) or to Bristol Hill.	<b>Major Haulers</b> must have an active account, and purchase a swipe card. Each card is \$10.00. <b>\$47/ton (2.35¢ per pound)</b> at ERF, must be burnable <b>only</b>
<b>RECYCLABLE</b>	<b>Scrap Metal</b> Metal sheeting, flashing, plumbing fixtures, piping, wire, aluminum, metal storm doors, aluminum window with no glass, re-bar and large metal appliances	<b>Must be separated from other waste.</b> Any load may be brought to Transfer Stations.	<b>No fee</b> for scrap metal only.  Each CFC refrigerant containing unit has a \$15 fee.
<b>ASBESTOS</b>	<b>Friable (Airborne)</b> Ceiling tiles and pipe insulation	All loads must go to Bristol Hill Landfill.  Any load over a 10 wheel truck must call office for directive at 591-9200.	<b>\$100/ton (5¢ per pound)</b> at Bristol Hill Landfill
<b>SOIL</b>	<b>Petroleum Contaminated Soil</b> Alternate Daily Cover (ADC)	All loads must be brought to Bristol Hill Landfill.  Call office for directive at 591-9200.	<b>\$25/ton (1.25¢ per pound)</b>

Oswego County Recycling and Solid Waste Local Law, 2 of 2011, requires that all Construction & Demolition Debris generated or collected within Oswego County must be delivered to Oswego County Solid Waste Facilities.
