Commercial Building	\$0.20/square foot
Residential 1 Story Building	\$0.20/square foot
Residential 2 Story Building	\$0.175/square foot
Garage and Sheds over 144 S.F	\$0.125/square foot
Interior Residential Renovation	\$0.125/square foot
Bathroom/Kitchen Renovation	\$0.20/square foot
In Ground Pool	\$0.15/square foot
Miscellaneous (Facades, etc...)	1% of total cost

External dimensions shall be used for Unit Based Permit Fees.

Minimum charge for any Demolition Permit is \$25.00.

The Value Based Fee Schedule (of 1/1/2006) will be compared to the Unit Based Fee Schedule and the largest fee amount shall be applied.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that in accordance with Section 126-22 of the Fire Protection and Building Construction Ordinance a Unit Based Demolition Permit Fee Schedule is recommended in addition to the Building Permit Fee Schedules; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Unit Based Demolition Permit Fee Schedule is hereby adopted effective May 28, 2014, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the aforementioned Value and Unit Based Building Permit Fee Schedules shall be applied together with the Unit Based Demolition Permit Fee Schedule.
