SUPERINTENDENT OF WASTEWATER TREATMENT

- A) A bachelor's degree with thirty (30) credit hours of math and/or science from a regionally accredited or New York State registered university or college;
OR
- B) An associate degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered university or college in a NYSDEC approved curriculum, plus eighteen (18) months or its part time equivalent operating experience at a wastewater treatment plant;
OR
- C) An associate degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered university or college and three (3) years or its part time equivalent operating experience at a wastewater treatment plant;
OR
- D) An associate degree with thirty (30) credit hours of math and/or science from a regionally accredited or New York State registered university or college, and three (3) years or its part time equivalent operating experience at a wastewater treatment plant;
OR
- E) Graduation from high school or New York State equivalency diploma and six (6) years or its part time equivalent operating experience at a wastewater treatment plant;
AND
- Completion of an appropriate approved course by the Commissioner, Department of Environmental Conservation;
AND
- Thirty-six (36) months or its part time equivalent operating experience at an activated sludge wastewater treatment plant with a point average score of 76 or greater, and the ability to perform necessary tests.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS:

Eligibility for a grade 4-A Chief Operator certificate issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation at time of appointment. Possession of the certificate at the time of appointment
