**Authorization:**

1. Thomas Kells, DPW Commissioner received a request from Jennifer Mays, owner of Oswego Expeditions, for use of the Gallagher Pool in order to host a “Fitness thru Nature” program.
2. The Engineering Department received a request for use of public space from ATW 3 LLC (Andy Whitman), owner of a single-family rental unit located in the First Ward at 205 West Seneca Street, for a one (1) car parking space between the sidewalk and property line fronting West Seneca Street together with a new 40” wide concrete step. (ATW 3 LLC has paved prior to this request) Attachment
3. The Engineering Department received a request from Tony Calasciabetta, owner of commercial property at 31 West Bridge Street, located in the Third Ward, for use of public space, eight foot by fifty-eight foot (8’X58’), for a proposed 36” high temporary free standing wrought iron railings with walk-in openings for a dining area together with an awning between the sidewalk and property line, fronting West Second Street. The proposed awning is eight foot by fifty-eight foot (8’x58’) and extends over public space approximately 8’. Attachment

The Engineering Department received a request from Adam Fay, owner of a single-family dwelling at 63 West Seneca Street, located in the First Ward, for use of public space, two foot by thirty foot (2’x30’) for a proposed thirty inch (30”) high retaining wall between the sidewalk and property line, fronting West Seneca Street. 5. Councilor Nate Emmons received a request from Chena Tucker, representing the Children’s Park Committee of Harborfest. Ms. Tucker is requesting approval of extending the usable space for our Novelis Family Park/ West Park to include the closure of West Third Street between West Cayuga and West Seneca for the Friday, July 29 and Saturday, July 30 of Harborfest, in order to have a 3 on 3 basketball tournament.
