WHEREAS, collecting, reporting, and sharing building energy data on a regular basis allows municipal officials and the public to understand the energy performance of municipal buildings relative to similar buildings nationwide, and equipped with this information the City of Oswego is able to make smarter, more cost-effective operational and capital investment decisions, reward efficiency, and drive widespread, continuous improvement, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Oswego desires to use Building Energy Benchmarking, a process of measuring a building's energy use, tracking that use over time, and comparing performance to similar buildings, to promote the public health, safety, and welfare by making available good, actionable information on municipal building use to help identify opportunities to cut costs and reduce pollution in the City of Oswego, and

WHEREAS, as such the Common Council for the City of Oswego desires to establish procedure or guideline for the City of Oswego staff to conduct such Building Energy Benchmarking, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the attached specific policies and procedures are hereby adopted and imposed as active and affirmative financial internal control procedures of the City of Oswego;

AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Oswego, in regular session duly convened does hereby authorize and direct the Mayor of the City of Oswego to execute such other and additional documents as may be required for to perfect the resolutions herein.
