

**PHYSICAL SERVICES
COMMITTEE MEETING
January 21, 2020**

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. in the 2nd floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Councilor Hill, Councilor Walker, Councilor Burrridge, and Councilor Gosek.

A motion to approve the minutes of December 2, 2019 was made by Councilor Walker and seconded by Councilor Gosek. Minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

I. OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business.

II. NEW BUSINESS:

1. William J. Barlow, Jr. has received a request from Ellen Clark regarding the Hearts on the Bridge Project for the month of February. Ellen Clark said that it is the five year anniversary of Hearts on the Bridge and that they are not asking for anything different this year. She said it will be ten hearts on the Bridge Street Bridge. Councilor Corradino asked if there was a cost to the City for this. Councilor Hill said there is a labor cost.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor Walker made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council to authorize the request from Ellen Clark regarding the Hearts on the Bridge Project for the month of February. Councilor Burrridge seconded the motion, and was unanimously approved.

The City of Oswego Special Events Committee through the Office of Economic Development has received a request from the Oswego Lions Club regarding the Annual River's Edge Craft Show to be held on Sunday, June 14, 2020, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Justin Rudgick said that this was a reoccurring event. He said that they still working on the logistics of the Breitbeck Park set up because of construction but they wanted to reserve it in advance.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor Gosek made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council to authorize the request from the Oswego Lions Club regarding the Annual River's Edge Craft Show to be held on Sunday, June 14, 2020, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Councilor Burrridge seconded the motion, and was unanimously approved.

The Special Events Committee though the Office of Economic Development has received a request from the Oswego City-County Youth Bureau to organize and host the Children's Easter Egg Hunt on April 11, 2020, beginning at 10 a.m. Justin Rudgick said that this is a reoccurring event that has been popular in the past.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor Walker made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council to authorize the request from the Oswego City-County Youth Bureau to organize and host the Children's Easter Egg Hunt on April 11, 2020, beginning at 10 a.m. Councilor Burrridge seconded the motion, and was unanimously approved.

THE RESOLUTION THAT WAS PART OF THE MEETING WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE FULL COUNCIL.

4. The City of Oswego Special Events Committee through the Office of Economic Development has received a request from the Oswego YMCA to hold the Annual Oswego YMCA Dragonboat festival from August 5-8, 2020. Justin Rudgick said that this is a reoccurring event. He said they put this in ahead of time so the YMCA could go ahead and order the boat they need for this event. He said in years past a fishing derby has also taken place on this date but they have not received an application this year from them yet.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor Burrridge made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council to authorize the request from the Oswego YMCA to hold the Annual Oswego YMCA Dragonboat festival

from August 5-8, 2020. Councilor Gosek seconded the motion, and was unanimously approved.

THE RESOLUTION THAT WAS PART OF THE MEETING WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE FULL COUNCIL.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:20 p.m. by Councilor Walker. A second was made by Councilor Burrige, and was unanimously approved.
