

**PHYSICAL SERVICES  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
January 22, 2019**

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

***II. NEW BUSINESS:***

**Authorization:**

1. The Engineering Department request use of public space on behalf of Edward Alberts, owner and contract purchaser of commercial properties located at 147-159 West First Street in the Third Ward, for a proposed new mixed use project. Bob Johnson said they want to bump out a piece on Cayuga Street to be able to accommodate parking. He said this resolution is about the work on Water Street and the new sidewalk and curbing on Cayuga Street. Councilor Hill said he fully supports this.

He said it will be on the same weekend as the next item. He said both groups have worked to make sure there are no issues.

Councilor DeMassi seconded the motion, unanimous approval.
