

**PHYSICAL SERVICES  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
November 16, 2020**

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order at 6:43 p.m.

A motion to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2020 Committee Meeting was made by Councilor Burrige and seconded by Councilor Walker. Minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

**I. OLD BUSINESS:** There was no old business.

**II. NEW BUSINESS:**

1. The Catherine C. Clark Trust, owners of a single-family dwelling located at 4 Woodridge Terrace, in the Sixth Ward, request the use of public space to place a landscaping rock garden along the roadway fronting East River Road. Jeff McGann said Keith and Cathy Clark are seeking support for use of public space for a project that is completed. McGann mentioned there was a miscommunication on his end and the project was completed before all of the approvals were in place. He explained that he worked alongside Engineer Hinderliter, a landscaper, and with the DOT to make sure the larger boulders used are held back far enough for safety reasons. He mentioned it is probably the most traveled gateway into the city and the rock garden certainly beautified it, and we should thank the homeowners for the time and tens of thousands of dollars they spent. Councilor Hill and Councilor Walker both agreed on how amazing it looks, and Councilor Walker said they have his support for sure.

**COMMITTEE DECISION:** Councilor Walker made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council the request for use of Public Space from the Catherine C. Clark Trust, owners of a single-family dwelling at 4 Woodridge Terrace, in the Sixth Ward, to place a landscaping rock garden along the roadway fronting East River Road.
