

**PHYSICAL SERVICES  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
November 5, 2018**

**Authorization:**

1. The Engineering Department received a request for use of public space from Kevin Jay, owner of a single-family dwelling located at 209 East Eleventh Street, seventy-three lineal feet (73 lf.) for a four foot (4') high wood fence between the sidewalk and property line fronting Catherine Street. Bob Johnson said he sees no problem with this.
