

**PHYSICAL SERVICES
COMMITTEE MEETING
December 3, 2018**

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. in the 2nd floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

Authorization:

1. The Engineering Department received a request for use of Public Space from Anthony Pauldine, owner of a commercial building, located at 197-203 West First Street in the Third Ward, for the seasonal placement of two (2) steel benches twenty-one inches by fifty inches (21"x50"), fronting Good Guys Barbershop as shown on map. Keith, from Good Guys Barbershop, said they will be moving their shop from the back of Canal Commons to the front. He said they had steel benches made to put out to the left and right of the door. Councilor Hill said the benches look great and he is in support.
