

**PHYSICAL SERVICES
COMMITTEE MEETING
June 4, 2018**

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order at 7:19 p.m. in the 2nd floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Councilor Hill, Councilor Wilmott, Councilor DeMassi, and Councilor Gosek.

A motion to approve the minutes of May 21, 2018 was made by Councilor Wilmott and seconded by Councilor DeMassi; minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

II. NEW BUSINESS:

Authorization:

1. The Engineering Department received a request from Brandon Porter, owner of a single-family dwelling at 46 East Seneca Street located in the Second Ward, for use of public space to install a new four foot (4') high fence between the sidewalk and property line fronting East Fourth Street. Councilor DeMassi said she is in support. She said he does a great job with his property.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor DeMassi made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council granting Brandon Porter, owner of a single-family dwelling at 46 East Seneca Street located in the Second Ward, use of public space to install a new four foot (4') high fence between the sidewalk and property line fronting East Fourth Street. COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor Gosek made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council granting approval to park the Bookmobile in City Parks and Street during their annual 2018 Summer Schedule and during the Movie Night in the Parks for East Park on June 27 and August 22, 2018. Councilor DeMassi seconded the motion, unanimous approval.
