## PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING March 18, 2019

Chairman Tesoriero called the meeting to order at 6:44pm in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

A motion to approve the minutes of March 4, 2019 was made by Councilor McBrearty and seconded by Councilor Corradino; minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

I. OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business.

## II. **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Mayor William J. Barlow, Jr. requests amendments to the Downtown Parking Policy. Mayor Barlow says that across from Karpinski's and Dufore's there is a municipal parking lot where Wayne's has an agreement to use some of the spaces and the rest is public parking. There are 6 parking spots in the lot designated by the police department for guest overnight parking. These six spaces you can pay \$5.00 to park there for the night but Chief DeCaire says it's never been used. Mayor Barlow says that for Ed Albert's DRI project, one of the commercial spaces sight plan needed to account for available parking, so we included these 6 spots in that. He says these spaces are still public parking and are not exclusive. He says in the downtown policy it states that these 6 spaces specifically are for guest parking so we have to strike that.

**<u>COMMITTEE DECISION:</u>** Councilor McBrearty made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to make amendments to the Downtown Parking Policy. Councilor Corradino seconded the motion, unanimous approval.

2. Mayor William J. Barlow, Jr. requests authorization for a Public Hearing regarding Proposed Local Law No. \*5 of the year 2019, a Local Law Amending Chapter 280,
