

**PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
June 17, 2019**

Chairman Tesoriero called the meeting to order at 6:57 p.m. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

A motion to approve the minutes of June 3, 2019 was made by Councilor McBrearty and seconded by Councilor Corradino; minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

**I. OLD BUSINESS:** There was no old business.

**II. NEW BUSINESS:**

1. The City Clerk's Office has received a request from Kristen DeSantis of The Sting of Oswego, Inc., for a waiver of the Noise Ordinance in order to have live music on the patio of their establishment. A Community Member (unnamed) said that in previous years they have had issues with this establishment playing loud music at unreasonable decibels and that several members of the community have asked for changes regarding this. She said she is happy to see that their requests have been met and she is hopeful that this will mean there is a better working relationship between The Sting and the community. Councilor McBrearty said that she has had an opportunity to meet with the owner of The Sting and that he is okay with the changes made to the Noise Ordinance.

**COMMITTEE DECISION:** Councilor Corradino made a motion to approve the request from Kristen DeSantis of The Sting of Oswego, Inc., for a waiver of the Noise Ordinance in order to have live music on the patio of their establishment. Councilor McBrearty seconded the motion, unanimous approval.
