## II. <u>NEW BUSINESS:</u>

## **Authorization:**

1. The Examining Board of Plumbers request approval of the revised Plumbing Code. Councilor Tesoriero said this is something that has been worked on for quite a few years. Curt Miller, Oswego Plumbing Inspector, said changes needed to be made. He said it will be updated with the current codes and new permit fees. Councilor Hill asked how many plumbers are certified to operate in the City of Oswego. Mr. Miller said 6 or 7.
