

**PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT
COMMITTEE MEETING**

July 2, 2018

A motion to approve the minutes of June 18, 2018 was made by Councilor Corradino and seconded by Councilor McBrearty; minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

I. OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business.

II. NEW BUSINESS:

Authorization:

1. Mark Tesoriero, City Clerk, requests authorization to issue Food Vendor Permits to vendors which do not operate at a fixed location such as Ice Cream Trucks and Hot Dog Carts. Mr. Tesoriero said the Food Vendor Ordinance states that you have to pick a specific place. He said he had an ice cream truck come in for a license and they want to be mobile. He said they were also thinking about hot dog carts. He said he is asking for it to be modified to include mobile.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Councilor McBrearty made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council granting authorization to issue Food Vendor Permits to vendors which do not operate at a fixed location such as Ice Cream Trucks and Hot Dog Carts. Councilor Corradino seconded the motion, unanimous approval (Councilor Tesoriero abstained).
